Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Park Commissioners of the City of Shelby, Ohio, at the Office of the Director of Finance and Public Records, Shelby City Hall, 43 West Main Street, Shelby, Ohio 44875, until 10:00 o'clock A.M., local time, **March 3, 2023**, for the Public Works Project consisting of the **SELTZER PARK PICKLEBALL COURTS**, Richland County, Ohio.

This project will consist of partially reconditioning the tennis courts at Seltzer Park and converting the reconditioned area to 3 pickleball courts, construction of an ADA accessible parking spot and sidewalk.

Bids must be plainly marked "**SELTZER PARK PICKLEBALL COURTS**". Bids must contain the full name and address of every person or firm interested in same and be accompanied by a performance bid bond or certified check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid payable to the City of Shelby, Ohio, as a guarantee that if the bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into and its performance properly secured. Should any bids be rejected, said check will be returned to the bidder upon the proper execution of a contract. The Project shall be completed within the time specified in the Information to Bidders after the execution of the Contract.

Bidders are further notified that a performance bond will be required. Partial payments will be made. This is the City of Shelby's NatureWorks Grant Project.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Richland County and the City of Shelby, Ohio as determined by the Ohio Bureau of Employment Services, Wage and Hour Division, (614) 644-2239.

The City of Shelby will entertain no bids of any person or firm in default to the City of Shelby, Ohio, and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
